Odour Log Instructions:

The Poultry Farm Odour Log will be a valuable record of odour events. If you would like to remain private, please tick the box. We will not reveal any details to the City of Gosnells. We will only reveal an approximate direction from the closest poultry farm (eg: SW of Poultry Farm). This will enable the recording and reporting of odour events that will be reported by the Association to the City of Gosnells, and allow for a level of privacy.

Date: The date of the odour event.

Time Started: The time of the day, approximately, that you first noticed the odour.

Time Ended: The time of the day, approximately, that you noticed that the odour was no longer noticeable or its intensity changed.

Wind Direction: The direction where the wind is blowing from during the event. Try to be as accurate as possible. A compass from a camping store can be as little as \$10. Other methods of determining where the wind is coming from is identify where the sun rises in the morning (east) and sets in the afternoon (west).

Odour Intensity: This is an approximate measure of the odour. It is on a scale of 1 to 10. An intensity of 1 is when you can just detect the odour. An intensity of 10 is the worst odour that you can remember. An intensity of 5 is when you consider the odour to be offensive. Try to be as "scientific" and objective as possible.

5/6/09	4:30pm	8:00pm	SW	4	Odour disappeared when wind changed to easterly.
6/6/09	9:00am		SW	6	Warm day, odour persisted all day
7/6/09	7:00am	12:00pm	SW	8	Warm day, really putrid odour. Still continued from last night.
7/6/09	12:00pm	4:00pm	W	3	Odour smell dropped with a change to a westerly wind
8/6/09	7:00am	10:00am	Calm	10	Warm day, really putrid odour. Odour dropped after easterly wind started.
